### WELCOME BACK

Welcome back for Term 3. I hope your family enjoyed the two week break and that our students are ready for a solid 10 weeks of learning.

### 3 WAY CONFERENCES

Last night we completed our 3 Way Conferences. All reports are that most families attended and that students did a great job participating in the process. If you have any concerns from your interview, please come and see myself or one of the other Assistant Principals. It is important to note that you do not have to wait five months to again see your child's teacher. Please make contact with the office if you wish to catch up with the teacher at any stage throughout the semester.

### CITY OF WHITTLESEA

There have been a number of developments to roads around our school this year. Initially the council added a crossing. Next up was the addition of more car parks around the school perimeter. During the school holidays the workers have completed the Lyndarum Drive roundabout and now the council have moved to Mansfield Street to continue developments. We thank our parents and wider school community for their patience and commend those who are driving safely in our school zone.



### UPCOMING CURRICULUM DAY

Each year schools are given four student free days. We have chosen this year to use two at the start of term and one on the Monday before Melbourne Cup Day. Our final one will be on Friday 16th August. Please endeavour to make arrangements for your children on this day. Our staff will be working on improvements to our assessment and reporting processes.

### NEW AND IMPROVED GROUNDS

Over the holiday break we had four major projects undertaken. We have installed a water tank in the Year Six area to assist with watering plants and grasses over on the far side of the school. We have had the painters in to add a number of fresh coats to the Pink Portable deck. Perfect Turf have installed all purpose synthetic turf around our prep playground as the heavy traffic in the area had turned the natural grass into dirt. As a major pick up point for prep students, these works will provide a fantastic area to be used either side of the 3:30pm dismissal time. Finally we have covered the rubber base of the Blue Building playground with synthetic grass. This was to solve an ongoing problem with the local birdlife damaging the original rubber surface. The playground will be reopened on Monday for the students to enjoy.



### NEW STAFF MEMBER

At the start of a new term we often have changes to our staffing at Epping Views. This time around we welcome Katie back from Family Leave to cover for Chloe in 2CD who is overseas for the majority of Term 3. It is wonderful to be able to cover staff with experienced replacements. We also are proud to announce that Fiona has joined us as our new Auslan teacher. Fiona will be working in Year Two and Year Three for this semester.

# E-Waste Recycling Skip

## DID YOU KNOW?

As a consequence of our love of technology, Australians produce an estimated 600 000 tonnes of e-waste each year!

The state government is looking at ways to review e-waste collection and upgrade storage facilities. As of July 1<sup>st</sup>, the Victorian government has banned e-waste from landfill.

## WHAT IS E - WASTE?

**E-waste is any discarded electrical/electronic equipment.** The following are just some of the e-waste items that can be put into the recycling skip: televisions, computers, laptops, tablets, printers, faxes, scanners, copiers, keyboards, speakers, monitors, gaming consoles, modems, set top boxes, routers, server, vacuum cleaners, toasters, hair dryers, hi-fi equipment, video and DVD players and other household electronic appliances.

## E – WASTE SKIP

At Epping Views Primary School, there will be an e-waste skip placed in the **Mansfield Street Carpark** for **three weeks**, from Monday, 15<sup>th</sup> July until Friday, 2<sup>nd</sup> August. Families at Epping Views Primary School are welcome to bring their e-waste and leave it **in** the skip.

## PLEASE MODEL OUR SCHOOL VALUES

**Be Responsible:** We ask that you dispose of **e-waste only**. Please ensure all items are in the skip, not on the ground around it. The skip will not be available after 2<sup>nd</sup> August.

**Be Caring:** Keep the area tidy and safely place the items in the skip.

**Be Respectful:** Only place **e-waste items** in the skip – this bin will be inspected and collected by the Whittlesea Council.
