ONLINE ORDERING Your child's school photos are now available for secure online purchase, please note if you are ordering online, you do not need to return an envelope to the school

4 EASY STEPS TO ONLINE SCHOOL PHOTO ORDERING

Step 1 Click Here - For online ordering process for your school.

- OR - Go to www.advancedlife.com.au before photo day and enter your school code [QPN V5H Z5N]

Step 2: Enter your student's details.

Step 3: Choose the package that best suits your needs (all orders will be returned to the school for collection)

Step 4: Pay for the photos via the shopping cart (upper right corner of the page)

**** Online Orders will attract a \$1 service fee**

Please Note: If you miss photo day, portrait and group packages can still be ordered online for 7 days afterwards with no late fees. After that time, late orders will require separate processing and handling and therefore will incur a \$15 late fee per package.

Oasis Camp Reptile IncurSION

Last week, the Year Threes had a visit from our friends Ash, Tahlia and Mark from the Oasis Camp. They brought some friendly reptiles to show us and here is what we have learned.

- The lizard families in Australia are dragons, skinks and goannas
- The reptiles we were introduced to had names based on 1. Where it lives 2. A description 3, which family they belong to ... so we met a Central bearded dragon, a Central pygmy bearded dragon, an Eastern shingle back skink and an Eastern blue tongue skink.
- There was also Rango and Monty the Children's pythons and Apples the rainbow python
- Reptiles are animals that are cold blooded, scaly and they shed their skin
- The Oasis pythons get fed with a rat once per month
- They can split their jaw open to swallow food
- If you hold a venomous snake by the tail, they can't reach up toward your hands BUT pythons have a lot of muscle and can reach up and wrap themselves around you.
