Scholarship Opportunity

I am writing to let you know about a scholarship opportunity available to students in Victorian public primary schools

Phillips Brothers Foundation Victorian Scholarships - open to current Year 4 students

Parents who believe their child may meet the criteria are invited to apply online. The child must be going into Year 5 in 2022 and meet the eligibility requirements to be considered.

There are a number of secondary scholarships also available:

<u>Acacia Program Scholarship - Victoria</u> - open to current Year 10 students in eligible schools or school regions in Victoria (see website for details of eligible schools)

<u>Friends of Zainab Secondary - Year 10 scholarship</u> - open to current Year 10 refugee students

<u>Friends of Zainab Secondary - Year 11 scholarship</u> - open to current Year 11 refugee students

<u>Harding Miller Education Foundation Scholarship</u> - open to eligible female students currently in Year

<u>Jack Brockhoff Victorian Indigenous scholarship</u> - open to current Year 10 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students

<u>PEF National Secondary Scholarships</u> - offering three different scholarships to eligible Year 9 students:

- o Financial Hardship
- o Indigenous
- o Refugee

Rural & Remote Indigenous Secondary scholarship - open to current Year 10 Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander students in rural or remote areas.

Music scholarships - offering two different scholarships (<u>Emorgo</u> and <u>Patricia Long</u>) to students who have been accepted for entry into the Conservatorium High School in Sydney

Tertiary transition scholarships:

<u>Friends of Zainab Tertiary scholarship</u> - open to current Year 12 refugee students to assist in their transitions to University or TAFE for tertiary studies

<u>Walter and Eliza Hall Trust Opportunity scholarship</u> - open to current Year 12 students with a permanent physical disability intending on completing their senior secondary education in 2020 and progressing to University in 2021 to study a degree

Tertiary transition applications have been open since May and close midnight Tuesday, 3rd August. Applications for Secondary scholarships close midnight 14th September, and for the Primary school scholarships, midnight 21st September.
